Grant in aid and Scholarship Awards

Scholarship Awards take into consideration the academic (GPA) performance, extracurricular activities, and individual participation in the community life of the Church and School. We also offer grant-in-aid awards that take into account financial need.

Those not yet enrolled in a DSPT program must apply to a MA program by the March 4 deadline for full consideration.

To be considered for Scholarships/Grants for the 2015-2016 school year:

- 1) Submit an original copy of the completed Scholarship Grant Application by **March 15** (for Fall applicants) or **November 1** (for Spring applicants).
- 2) Submit the 2015-2016 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the U.S. Department of Education by our priority deadline (March 15). **Our Federal School Code is: 016673**

N. B. Applications for Scholarships and Grants are still accepted and reviewed after these priority deadlines on a case by case basis.

Jubilee Year Scholarships:

We are excited to announce the St. Dominic 800th Year Jubilee Scholarships! In addition to other merit-based scholarships available, two full scholarships will be awarded to MA students applying for admission in Fall 2016. All scholarships will be based on academic record, quality of the submitted personal statement, letters of recommendations, and quality of the writing sample. Extracurricular activities that illustrate collaborative leadership skills will enhance an academically strong application. In addition to these merit-based scholarships, DSPT also provides Grant-in-Aid awards that take into account the financial need of our students.

Scholarship & Grant-in-Aid Eligibility

If you are interested in applying for scholarships, grants-in-aid, and/or federal loans you should know:

- DSPT offers Scholarships and Grant in Aid
- The GTU handles all federal student loans

Applicants must:

- Be enrolled full-time in a DSPT MA program (including GTU MA)
- Register for at least 9 and no more than 12 semester units of coursework each semester.

Initial award amounts are based on a 12-unit enrollment. If a student registers for less than 12 units, the award amount is reduced proportionately. In no cases is an award made for more than 12 semester units.
